Senior Elementary School Walk Wednesday, May 22, 8 a.m. at ROHS

- Senior Elementary School Walk through the hallways. (buses take participating seniors to ROISD elementary schools)
- Your cap and gown are required for this event.
- Return by bus to ROHS.
- Seniors are to leave immediately after returning and not enter the high school.

GRAD PRACTICE

Required Commencement Practice (*Seniors Only*) Tuesday, May 28, 2024, at 10 a.m. at Red Oak High School Cafeteria

All seniors participating in the commencement ceremony at the Dr. Jim Vaszauskas Center for the Performing Arts <u>MUST</u> be present and participate in the practice.

This practice is necessary for planning and making the ceremony serene and dignified. Seniors wearing inappropriate school dress or exhibiting behavior that violates the ROISD Code of Conduct at the practice will lose the opportunity to participate in the ceremony on May 29 at the Dr. Jim Vaszauskas Center for the Performing Arts.

SPECIAL - Bring your cap and gown for a special School Board photo opportunity with School Board members at the end of practice!

- Seniors ONLY and Mandatory MUST have Student ID to be issued tickets at practice.
- If seniors do not attend, they will not be allowed to participate in the actual commencement ceremony.
- Seniors must return all ROISD issued devices, clear all fines, etc. before receiving tickets.
- Tickets (10 per grad) will be distributed to seniors ONLY after practice by lottery selection.
- Tickets are numbered and seats bundled together by 10. Students will draw a bundle.
- Per MISD policy, tickets are required for ALL guests (including infants) and are specific seats (not general admission). If you have a lap infant, stop by Will Call to acquire an extra ticket for the infant to enter.
- Once tickets are issued and signed for by the senior, they will not be replaced.

DAY-OF SENIOR PROCEDURES

ARRIVAL TIME

All seniors <u>MUST</u> be at Red Oak High School by 8 a.m. on Wednesday, May 29 to be bused to the graduation facility. Graduates will ride back with their families/friends after the ceremony. Seniors should bring only their cap, gown, and ROHS-issued collars, cords, or stoles. Staff members will be onsite to assist with caps, gowns, etc. and to ride the buses with seniors. Seniors will not be allowed to possess cameras, cell phones, or any other electronic devices on the stage. ROHS staff will gather all items from students before the ceremony.

STUDENT DRESS

For the best pictures, men should wear dark slacks or a suit, with a button-down shirt and preferably a tie with dark colored shoes. Ladies should wear a modest dress or dress pants with black or neutral-colored flats or wedges or low heels. High heels are not recommended due to the lengthy walk within the facility. No flip-flops, house shoes, or sneakers please. All clothing must be ROISD Student Dress Code. Writing or messages on any clothing, cap, or gown is not allowed. The 'mortarboard' style cap should be worn flat on the top of the head. Decorations will NOT be allowed on the cap.

CAP AND GOWN ORDERS

In order to have matching Red Oak maroon attire, participating seniors <u>MUST</u> order their cap and gown from Halls Recognition. Be sure to try on your gown to make sure it fits and iron it before the ceremony. Borrowing a Red Oak gown older than three years will be the wrong color.

GUEST & TICKET INFORMATION

- Parking is free, but carpooling is recommended.
- Doors open for guests at 11 a.m., no re-entry allowed.
- Everyone will go through metal detectors and have all bags checked. (*Leave unnecessary items in the car.*)
- Meet your graduate out front after the ceremony.

The Center opens one (1) hour prior to graduation and abides by a strict "no *re-entry*" *policy during events.* All guests are subject to bag checks by security personnel. A ticket is required for each guest.

- Tickets (10 per grad) will be distributed to seniors after practice May 28.
- Per MISD policy, tickets are required for ALL guests (including infants) and are specific seats (not general admission). If you have a lap infant, stop by Will Call to acquire an extra ticket for the infant to enter.
- A limited number of extra tickets MAY be available at the Center's box office the day of graduation. They also have an overflow room on site where guests can watch a live stream of the ceremony.

Noisemakers, helium balloons, large signs, strollers, food, beverages, coolers, and large bags <u>are not permitted</u>.

After the ceremony, families should meet graduates in front of the Dr. Jim Vaszauskas Center for the Performing Arts. MISD officials ask that all guests exit the arena within 30 minutes after the ceremony's conclusion. Graduates will be riding home with parents/family or friends.


