

ROISD STUDENT PROCESS MAP FOR COVID-19(AUG 2024)

PRIOR TO SCHOOL

AT SCHOOL

Student is **TEST Confirmed** to have COVID-19.

Student is SUSPECTED of having COVID 19. Student reports having "close contact" with someone who is **TEST Confirmed** to have COVID-19.

Student reports someone in their home was exposed to someone who is **TEST Confirmed** to Have COVID 19.

Student develops one or more symptoms of COVID-19 during the school day.

The student does not report to school or participate in other school activities.

Parent reports the absence to the campus.

May return to regular activities when, for at least 24 hours, symptoms are improving overall. If fever was present, at least 24 hours have passed without the use of fever-reducing medication.

CDC recommends wearing a mask for 5 days after returning to normal activity.

Upon notification of a test-confirmed COVID-19 positive on a campus, the district will follow reporting guidelines of TDSHS. The student does not report to school or participate in other activities.

Parent reports the absence to the campus.

Recommended the student contact their primary care provider for guidance.

May return to regular activities when, for at least 24 hours, symptoms are improving overall. If fever was present, at least 24 hours have passed without the use of fever-reducing medication.

CDC recommends wearing a mask for 5 days after returning to normal activity.

Student shall report to school and monitor their health as usual.

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The campus nurse will follow protocols for evaluation of an ill student at school.
